NOTICE

If you have the ability to make payments towards your court ordered financial obligations, you may avoid a personal court appearance by submitting a written motion for approval of a monthly payment plan.

A form motion is enclosed for this purpose.

If your motion is allowed, an order will be entered and mailed to you. If it is denied, you will receive a notice to appear in court for a later date. If you do neither, a warrant may issue for your arrest.

INSTRUCTIONS FOR COMPLETING THE MOTION FOR PAYMENT PLAN

- 1. Print your name legibly on the blank line labeled "Defendant."
- 2. List **all your applicable your case numbers** in the blank lines to the right of your name.
- 3. Fill in the dollar amount of your proposed payment plan and the month in which you can begin making these payments.
- 4. Sign and print your name on the appropriate lines.
- 5. Submit the motion to the Circuit Clerk's Office in person or by mail so that it is received prior to your court date. Faxed or emailed copies cannot be accepted.
