

June Month-End Report

12 draft applications, issued 11 permits, 177 open permits, 4 open complaints & conducted 11 site visits at various locations throughout the county. Revenues: \$4,519 mtd, \$45,326 ytd .

- Met with Rebecca Kenison, (new) Executive Director of SIMPAC. Discussed reorganization of SIMPAC, current and future initiatives.
 - I provided a full report for the board at the March meeting, see attached.
 - It is my opinion that this organization is now viable and headed in the right direction. There is still work to be done but SIMPAC can be instrumental in providing Bond county support for economic development, support in updating and creating ordinances & grant funding opportunities.
 - It is still my position that Bond county is not required and should not be responsible for the full burden of the cost for the county nor should the county pay for any prior dues requirements.
 - I propose the board vote to pay dues starting in January, 2024 based of the per capita population of the unincorporated portion of the county totaling \$2,234.95 per fiscal year.
