

## May Month-End Report

*10 draft applications, issued 9 permits, 111 open permits, no open complaints & conducted 13 site visits at various locations throughout the county.*

*Revenues: \$3,570 mtd, \$26,559 ytd .*

They will also take up a special use permit request for a small rural business in an agricultural district. Recommendations will be presented to the county board on 7.5.23.
