At 4:00 p.m., Chairman, Chris Timmermann, opened the meeting by leading the Pledge of Allegiance. Roll Call showing a quorum present as follows: Chris Timmermann, Wes Pourchot, Bernard Myers, and Jeff Rehkemper. Jacob Rayl was absent.

The minutes of the June 16, 2026, regular meeting were approved as submitted with a motion made by Wes Pourchot second by Jeff Rehkemper. Roll Call Vote: 4 ayes, 0 nays, motion carried.

The bills listed on Edit Reports dated June 17, 2026, and July 2, 2026 (see attached) were approved as submitted with a motion made by Jeff Rehkemper second by Wes Pourchot. Roll Call Vote: 4 ayes, 0 nays, motion carried.

The County Clerk's report for the month of June 2026 (see attached) was approved as submitted with a motion made by Wes Pourchot second by Bernard Myers. Roll Call Vote: 4 ayes, 0 nays, motion carried.

There was no Public Comment.

The Board reviewed Zoning Administrator Brad Criner's June 2026 report which included permits, inspections, solar permits and meeting schedules (see attached).

The Board reviewed Highway Engineer Mike McCormick's June 2026 report (see attached).

The Board approved Resolution 07-07-26-01 Joint Funding Agreement with IDOT for funding engineering for the Woburn Road Bridge replacement project with a motion made by Jeff Rehkemper second by Wes Pourchot. Roll Call Vote: 4 ayes, 0 nays, motion carried.

Chairman Chirs Timmermann referred the Board to the correspondence from the Bond County Democratic Central Committee, recommending the appointment of Brooke Weathers to fulfill the County Clerk & Recorder term, being November 30, 2026. The Chairman asked if any Board member had any objection to this recommendation. Being none, Chairman Timmermann, as provided by State Statue, appointed Brooke Weathers to fulfill the unexpired term for County Clerk and Recorder ending November 30, 2026.

Chairman Chirs Timmermann referred the Board to the correspondence from the Bond County Democratic Central Committee, recommending the appointment of Rena Ward to fulfill the Board of Review to fulfill Ron Shevlin's term, being April 30, 2028. The Chairman asked if any Board member had any objection to this recommendation. Being none, Chairman Timmermann, as provided by State Statue, appointed Rena Ward to fulfill the unexpired term for Board of Review ending April 30, 2028.

The Board approved the Coroner's Report for the month of June 2026 (see attached) with a motion made by Wes Pourchot second by Jeff Rehkemper. Roll call vote: 4 ayes, 0 nays. Motion carried

Under Old Business, Jeff Rehkemper stated that he believes greater focus should be placed on a new Sheriff's Department building and that the County should rehab the current Courthouse. He also said he would distribute information from Representative Mary Miller's office regarding potential grant opportunities that the County may be eligible to apply for.

There was no New Business

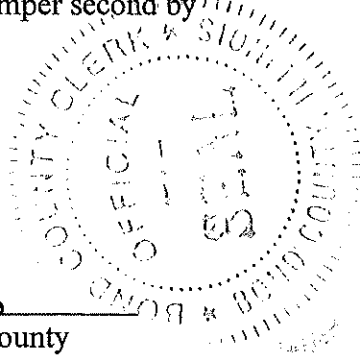
