In Old Business Jacob stated that the Radio Tower project has been put on hold.

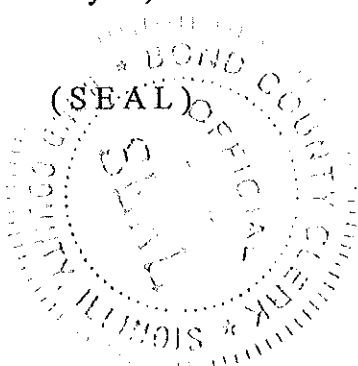

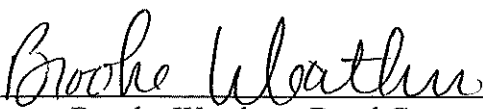
Josh Hill stated that the Building Committee is still meeting and is in no hurry to begin construction. He expects to have more information available by the second meeting in August.
