Roll Call Vote: 5 ayes, 0 nays, motion carried. The request for their Christmas event was previously approved with a request from the City of Greenville.

The Board discussed the need for an ADA compliant button to open the door into the Annex from the street. A motion to turn this over to the PBC Board was made by Wes Pourchot second by Jacob Rayl. Roll Call Vote: 5 ayes, 0 nays, motion carried.

The Board accepted the request to withdraw Marcoot Jersey Creamery's liquor license application with a motion made by Joseph Whalen second by Gerald McCray. Roll Call Vote: 5 ayes, 0 nays, motion carried.

The Board approved the Sheriff's Report for the month of August 2022 (see attached) with a motion made by Gerald McCray second by Wes Pourchot. Roll Call Vote: 5 ayes, 0 nays, motion carried.

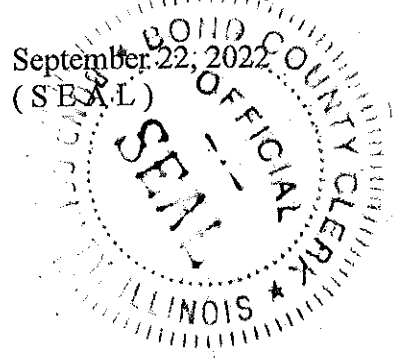

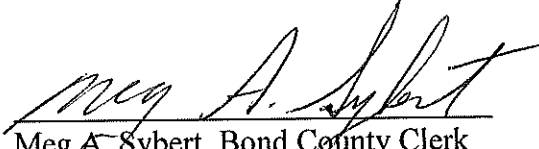
Under Old Business, Jacob Rayl discussed the Broadband presentation and the Bond County fiber middle mile RFP that is to be submitted on October 12.
