

Board members discussed meeting space for the Bond County Review. After discussion, motion to table was made by Wes Pourchot second by Jeff Rehkemper. Roll Call Vote: 5 ayes, 0 nays, motion carried.

The Board announced three openings on the Bond County Zoning Board of Appeals with James Tarasuik and Chad Waters seeking reappointment and Kelli Bassett being recommended to replace Carol Lingley who is resigning.

The Board appointed Lou Lorton to the Greenville Airport Authority Board to a five-year term set to expire March 7, 2028 with a motion made by Wes Pourchot second by Jacob Rayl. Roll Call Vote: 5 ayes, 0 nays, motion carried.

The Board announced two openings on the Hazel Dell Cemetery Board with Darrell Mollett and Sally Stone being recommended for reappointment.

The Board approved the Coroner's Report for the Month of January 2023 (see attached) with a motion made by Chris Timmerman second by Wes Pourchot. Roll Call Vote: 5 ayes, 0 nays, motion carried.

The Board approved the Annual Animal Control Report for 2022 (see attached) with a motion made by Jacob Rayl second by Wes Pourchot. Roll Call Vote: 5 ayes, 0 nay, motion carried.

Under New Business, County Clerk Meg Sybert informed the Board of legislation that passed in the most recent Lame Duck Session of the Illinois General Assembly wherein it will add \$10 to the current recording fee to be sent to the State for the Rental Housing Support Program. Currently, state statute requires that \$10 be collected for this program. After July 1, 2023, this will jump to \$20 per recording. Meg will be drafting a resolution for the Board to pass in a future meeting.


Also, under New Business, Jeff Rehkemper informed the Board of an interest in starting a Bond County Youth Board similar to what Madison County currently has.
