An opening on the Shoal Creek Fire Protection District Board was announced with Brett Kunkel being recommended.

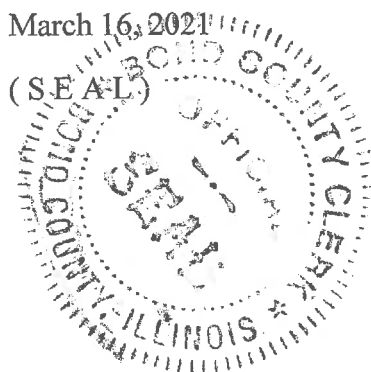
Meg Sybert announced a reminder to the Board that starting in April the second Board meeting will be in the evening and remain through September.
