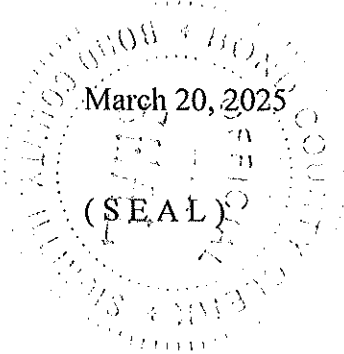


There was no Old Business.
