The Board appointed Chad Sexton to the Greenville Fire Protection District Trustee Board with a term to end April 30, 2025 with a motion made by Jeff Rehkemper second by Chris Timmermann. Roll Call Vote: 5 ayes, 0 nays, motion carried.

Under Old Business, Jeff Rehkemper asked why the Highway Department was not on the Agenda. Jeff said he thought the Board had agreed that the Highway Department would be on the Agenda until they felt things were properly being taken care of in the County. After discussion, it was agreed that the Highway Department will be listed on the Agenda each meeting until further notice. 
Finally, under Old Business, Chris Timmermann said he is still waiting on an updated culvert list and the projected installation timeline as to when they will be installed.
