Proceedings had before the Honorable Board at the regular meeting of said Board, begun and held in person and via Video Conference in the City of Greenville in said County and State, on Wednesday, April 2, 2025, held for the transaction of general County business.

Due to severe weather this meeting started early at 6:52 p.m., Chairman, Chris Timmermann, opened the meeting by leading the Pledge of Allegiance. Roll Call showing a quorum present as follows: Chris Timmermann, Jacob Rayl, Wes Pourchot, and Bernard Myers. Jeff Rehkemper was absent.

The minutes of the March 18, 2025 regular meeting were approved as submitted with a motion made by Jacob Rayl second by Bernard Myers. Roll Call Vote: 4 ayes, 0 nays, motion carried.

LaDonna Koeberlein and Mel Kelly from SAFE Crisis Center were in attendance to present to the Board the Bond County Board Proclamation (see attached) in support of April being Sexual Assault Awareness Month. Chairman Chris Timmermann signed the proclamation and thanked them for attending.

The Board reviewed Zoning Administrator Brad Criner's March 2025 report which included permits, inspections and revenues (see attached).

The Board reviewed Highway Engineer Mike McCormick's March 2025 report which included maintenance updates, fire repairs, proposed project updates, equipment status, and permits (see attached). Mike was not able to attend the meeting due to the severe weather. The Board agreed to table Resolution 04-02-25-01 the Jurisdictional Transfer Agreement for Baumann Road until the April 15, 2025 meeting with a motion made by Jacob Rayl second by Wes Pourchot. Roll Call Vote: 4 ayes, 0 nays, motion carried.

The Board approved the recommendation from the Bond County Republican Central Committee to appoint Josh Hill as Bond County Sheriff effective May 2, 2025 with a motion made by Jacob Rayl second by Wes Pourchot. Roll Call Vote: 4 ayes, 0 nays, motion carried.

The Board appointed Edmar Schreiber to fulfill a term set to expire April 30, 2026 and Don Hawley for a three-year term set to expire April 30, 2028 to the Pocahontas-Old Ripley Fire Protection District Board with a motion made by Jacob Rayl second by Bernard Myers. Roll Call Vote: 4 ayes, 0 nays, motion carried.

The Board approved the use of the Courthouse lawn requested by the Illinois 102 County Network on April 12, 2025 at noon with a motion made by Jacob Rayl second by Wes Pourchot. Roll Call Vote: 4 ayes, 0 nays, motion carried.

The Board announced two openings on the Smithboro Fire Protection District Board with Bill Archibald and Randy Tevis being recommended for reappointment.

The Board approved the Sheriff's February 2025 Report with a motion made by Wes Pourchot second by Bernard Myers. Roll Call Vote: 4 ayes, 0 nays, motion carried.


