Frank Lucco and Gerald McCray joined the meeting.

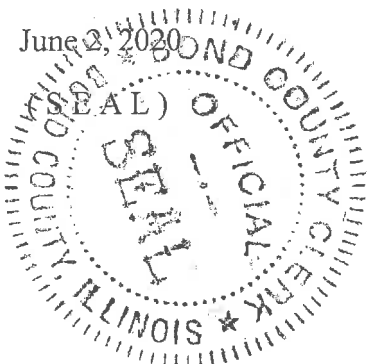
The Sheriff shared information about the Rebuild Illinois Grant. The grant would include funds for building a new jail. This grant would require a blueprint for the potential jail building along with a packet of information that they would need to submit by June 15th. With a short deadline, the Sheriff would like to contract with a firm that would help them meet the grant requirements by the June 15 deadline, with a cost of approximately \$10,000. A motion to turn this proposal over to the Public Building Commission to consider was made by Gerald McCray second by Eldon Young. Roll Call Vote: 5 ayes, 0 nays, motion carried.


The Board approved a Liquor License for Double J Plus One INC. doing business as 3st Place Bar and Grill, Nuby's Steakhouse, and The Family Vine with a motion made by Gerald McCray and second by Adam Boudouris. Roll Call Vote: 5 ayes, 0 nays, motion carried.

Three openings on the Bond County Board of Health were announced with Mark Bleyer, Dr. Matthew McCullough and William Ahern seeking reappointment.

Under New Business, Gerald McCray told the Board that he received many Thank yous from the community regarding the Red Ball Trail Bridge. He said that there was an accumulation of oil sitting on the bridge making it slick to drive on and this problem was fixed.
