
The Board approved Bob Jackson as Treasurer of the Mulberry Grove Sanitation Board to fulfill an unexpired term of Yvette Hall to end April 30, 2025 with a motion made by Jeff Rehkemper second by Wes Pourchot. Roll Call Vote: 5 ayes, 0 nays, motion carried.

Under Old Business, Highway Engineer Jeremy Pestle was in attendance, he gave an update on Ripson Bridge. He informed the Board that he had a meeting in the morning with HMG Engineering to get the intersection approved, once that is done it will then be given to the Railroad for approval. He also updated the Board on the Highway Department fleet status and building clean up. He will be picking up 2 dump trucks Monday and is currently repairing one. He said they have plows and equipment to go with these trucks to be ready for Winter. He has already purchased a service truck and is in hopes to purchase one more dump truck in the near future. The materials for the roof are to be delivered sometime in October. Once the roof is replaced they will then finish demo and cleaning. The overhead doors will be replaced at that time. The electrical system will need to be either repaired or replaced. To repair it will be at least a year wait due to shortage of parts for this being an older system. To replace is only a 4 month wait and seems to be the better option due to the system being 20 years old. He will get pricing to the Board once the roof has been replaced. Jeff Rehkemper asked if he had looked into having the Bond County Highway Department identification put on the trucks yet. He said he had not and that there is plenty of time to do that. Lastly, he updated the Board on the status of Pokey Road. They are still patching and there is no oil date set as of yet. He plans to hire this out to not have as much loose rock.

This meeting adjourned at 7:50 p.m. with a motion made by Wes Pourchot second by Jeff Rehkemper. Roll Call Vote: 5 ayes, 0 nays, motion carried.
