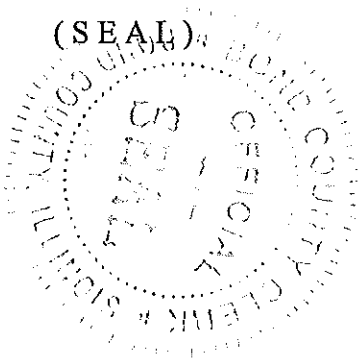

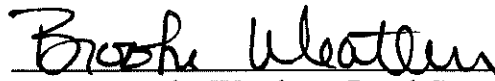
Jacob Rayl mentioned that the budget is nearly complete, and they are waiting on a few outstanding items from certain departments.

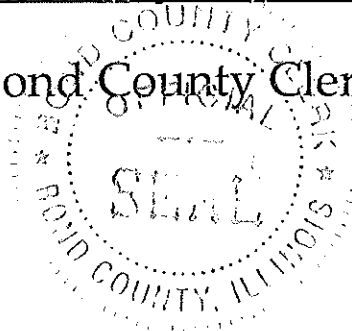

Tax Buyer

Interest rate is charged in 6mo intervals for tax sale year. (Potential of owners paying more in interest) Tax buyers likely to only bid high

Tax Deed Auction (Sheriff Sale) for each property. Maybe that means one sale per buyer if they do all theirs at the same time maybe that means one sale per parcel

Treasurer's Office must send notification to potential owners of surplus equity which means more expense for the county

Taxing districts get the taxes which tax buyers are paying at the tax sale in final distribution for the year.

Redemption must be paid in full (35 ILCS 200/21-355)

OF THE
COUNTY BOARD OF THE COUNTY OF BOND, ILLINOIS**

**A RESOLUTION AMENDING PREVIOUS RESOLUTION DATED JUNE 18, 2019
ESTABLISHING CIRCUIT COURT CLERK FEES AND
CRIMINAL AND TRAFFIC ASSESSMENTS
TO BE CHARGED BY THE CLERK OF THE CIRCUIT COURT**

WHEREAS, the previous Resolution dated June 18, 2019 of Bond County currently set forth the fees authorized by the County Board to be charged and collected in both civil and criminal cases in Bond County; and

WHEREAS, the Illinois General Assembly passed comprehensive legislation in 2019, which completely overhauls the criminal, traffic and civil fee structures in the circuit courts throughout the State of Illinois; and

WHEREAS, the purpose of the legislation was to consolidate fees into unified schedules for all counties, to realign fees to be constitutional, and to provide for fee waivers for low income individuals; and

WHEREAS, effective July 1, 2019, Section 27.1b of the Clerks of Courts Act, 705 ILCS 105/27.1b, sets out the fees to be charged in all counties in the State of Illinois by the Clerks of the Circuit Court for the filing of pleadings and for other services provided by the Clerks in civil cases; and

WHEREAS, Section 27.1b of the Clerks of Courts Act creates four schedules for civil filing fees, three schedules for civil appearance fees, and establishes various other fees that Clerks of the Circuit Court are authorized to collect for services, all of which are generally classified as "not to exceed" amounts; and

WHEREAS, Section 27.1b provides that, unless otherwise specified, the amount of the fees shall be determined by ordinance or resolution of the county board and remitted to the county treasurer to be used for purposes related to the operation of the court system in the county; and

WHEREAS, effective July 1, 2019, the newly-adopted Criminal and Traffic Assessment Act, 705 ILCS 135/ et seq., sets out minimum fines to be levied and assessments to be charged in criminal and traffic cases by the Clerks of the Circuit Court in all counties in the State of Illinois; and

WHEREAS, Sections 15-5 through 15-65 of the Criminal and Traffic Assessment Act establish thirteen (13) assessment schedules for various criminal, traffic, conservation and non-traffic offenses, and for each schedule the County's portion of the assessment is specifically listed; and

WHEREAS, Sections 15-5 through 15-65 break down how the assessment amounts are to be distributed to various County funds, if those funds are in existence; otherwise, the amounts designated for funds that are not in existence are to be placed in the County's general fund for purposes related to operation of the court system in the County.

WHEREAS, the Governor of Illinois signed into law Public Act 104-0468 and parts of the act amend 705 ILCS 105/27.1b(a), 705 ILCS 105/27.1b(b) by adding a \$5.00 fee to the Guardianship and Advocacy Fund

and repeals the Guardianship and Advocacy Operations Fee under 705 ILCS 105/27.3(f) and removes the Current Account fee for a ward of \$25.00 under 705 ILCS 105/27.1b(v) from the Guardianship case – GR/P.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the County Board for the County of Bond, Illinois, that the previous Resolution dated June 18, 2019 of Bond County is hereby repealed in its entirety and replaced with the following:

Fees shall not be charged in any adoption, criminal or quasi-criminal case, in any matter coming to the clerk on change of venue, or in any proceeding to review the decision of any administrative officer, agency, or body.

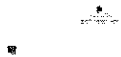

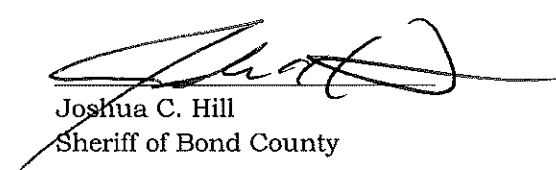
