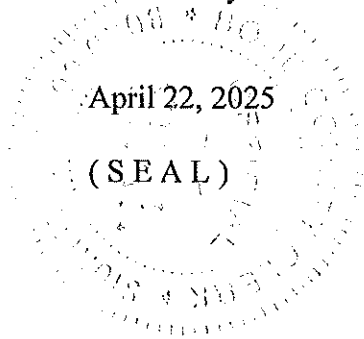

INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT
between
Bond County Sheriff Department
City of Greenville
County of Bond
Emergency Telephone Systems Board
Kaskaskia Community College

WHEREAS, Internet access and speeds of access have recently changed; and

WHEREAS, various Internet service providers have differing connection points and levels of service; and

WHEREAS, the Bond County Sheriff Department and the Greenville Police Department need to be connected to the Illinois State Police database for criminal and motor vehicle data; and

WHEREAS, each party may be able to utilize fiber optic connections to provide off site backup capability; and

WHEREAS, in order to reduce overall expense all of the parties to this agreement desire to share an Internet service connection that is higher speed and lower cost;

NOW THEREFORE, the parties agree to share in the construction and monthly expenses as follows:

Construction cost to extend fiber-optic cable from a Greenville University location to the Bond County Courthouse and then to the Municipal Building and Bond County Sheriff's Office is approximately \$50,000.00. Monthly expense for 100 Mbs symmetrical Internet service is approximately \$840.00 per month. Each party shall pay at the rate and proportion shown on the chart below:

Note 1: Kaskaskia Community College will pay the cost of extension from the handhold at Oak St and the alley to the Kaskaskia College Building on 2nd St; Kaskaskia Community College has no upfront expense for the general bulldout, but spreads \$10,000 over 60 months; at the end of 60 months, the monthly cost is reduced to \$168.00 per month

Note 2: Any future participant pays an initial \$10,000 (\$2,000 to each original participant); the excess monthly cost paid reduces all original participants monthly by 1/5 of \$168.00.

During the full term of the agreement the City of Greenville shall pay the associated bills and each other participant shall reimburse the City of Greenville in the amount determined by this agreement. All payments shall be made monthly. Any monthly cost increases or reductions shall be shared proportionately at the time they occur. Equipment repair, maintenance, or replacement shall be shared equally among the then current participants.

This agreement shall be for an initial term of 5 years and shall renew automatically for additional 5 year terms. After the initial 5 year term any party to the agreement may choose to cease participation by providing 6 months' notice to the other parties.

This agreement is entered into this 1st day of May, 2018.





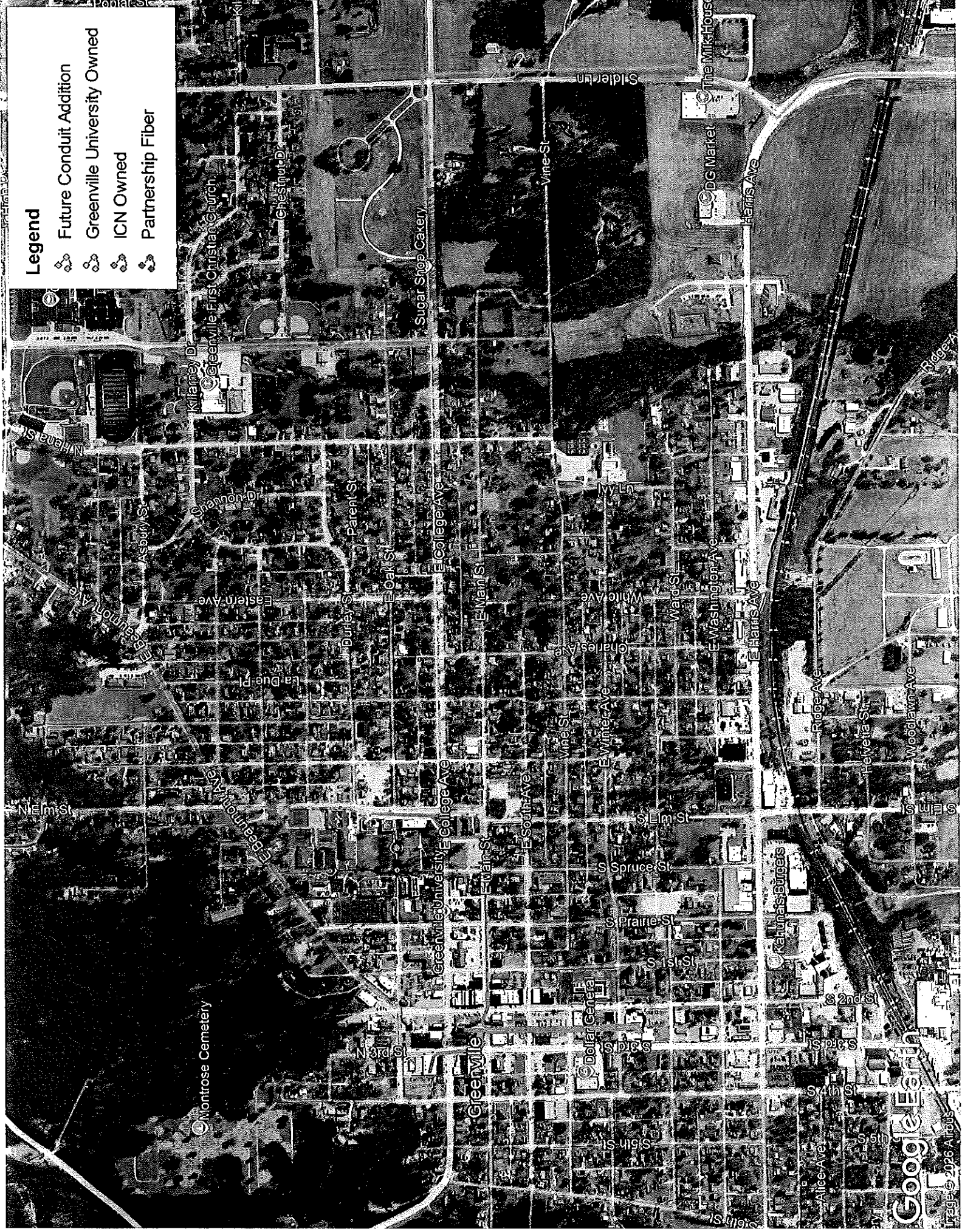

AN RESOLUTION BY THE BOND COUNTY BOARD ADOPTING THE SALARY SCHEDULE FOR BOND COUNTY CIRCUIT CLERK, SUPERVISOR OF ASSESSMENTS, TREASURER AND COUNTY CLERK AND RECORDER

WHEREAS, County Boards have the authority to set salaries of County Elected Officials within the guidelines set forth in the Illinois Revised Statutes at 55 ILCS 5/4-6001, and

WHEREAS, salaries for elected officials must be set at least 180 days prior to the date the elected official assumes the duties of the office; and

WHEREAS, the office of Clerk of the Circuit Court is established pursuant to Article VI, Section 18 of the Illinois Constitution and further addressed in 705 ILCS 105/27.3; and

WHEREAS, the office of Supervisor of Assessments is established pursuant to 35 ILCS 200/3-40, and while the Illinois Constitution identifies the office of County Assessor as a county officer, it does not specifically designate the Supervisor of Assessments as a constitutional county officer; and

WHEREAS, the Bond County Board finds it appropriate to establish a consistent compensation structure by linking certain county office salaries to that of the Sheriff; now,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNTY BOARD OF BOND COUNTY, ILLINOIS THAT THE SALARY SCHEDULE BE SET FOR THE CLERK OF THE CIRCUIT COURT, THE SUPERVISOR OF ASSESSMENTS, THE COUNTY TREASURER AND THE COUNTY CLERK AND RECORDER as set forth below:

Beginning 12-1-2026 and thereafter, salary shall be set at seventy-five percent (75%) of the salary of the Bond County Sheriff, which Sheriff's salary is established pursuant to Illinois law as a percentage of the salary of the State's Attorney, as set by the State of Illinois.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that any additional compensation provided by the State of Illinois to County Officers in the form of stipends shall be considered "in addition to" or "separate and apart" from the compensation established by the Bond County Board, and shall not be used to reduce or otherwise impair the salaries established herein.

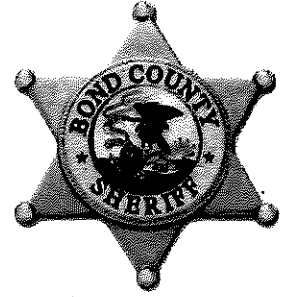
