

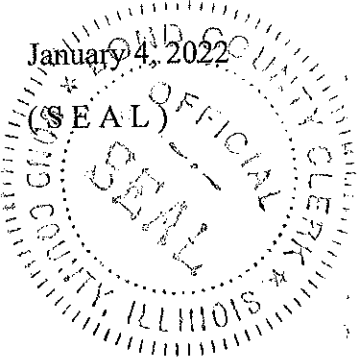


Proceedings had before the Special Services District Members at a meeting of said Members, begun and held at the Courthouse in the City of Greenville in said County and State, on Tuesday, January 4, 2022, held for the transaction of SSD Business.

At 9:00 a.m., Chairman, Adam Boudouris, opened the meeting by leading the Pledge of Allegiance. Roll Call showing a quorum present as follows: Adam Boudouris, Jacob Rayl, Joseph Whalen, Gerald McCray and Wes Pourchot.

Ethan and Kim Bouser with Rural Med were in attendance to give the Board an update on their first year in the County. Ethan informed the Board that Rural Med had 1,384 911 calls, 862 interfacility transfers which totals 2,246 for the year. Their yearly average chute time is 1 minute 45 seconds and their average time to scene is 5 minutes and 6 seconds. They also included their revenue and projected loss (see attached). Ethan informed the Board that they are currently fully staffed and very happy with their first year.
