Proceedings had before the Special Services District Board at a meeting of said Members, begun and held in person in the City of Greenville in said County and State, on Tuesday, October 21, 2025, held for the transaction of SSD Business.

At 6:17 p.m., Chairman, Chris Timmermann, opened the meeting. Roll Call showing a quorum present as follows: Chris Timmermann, Jacob Rayl, Wes Pourchot, and Bernard Myers. Jeff Rehkemper was absent.

After discussion, the Board approved Ordinance 10-21-25-SD1 Authorizing Tax Rates with a motion made by Jacob Rayl second by Wes Pourchot. Roll Call Vote: 4 ayes, 0 nays, motion carried.

After discussion, the Board approved Ordinance 10-21-25-SD2 Budget and Appropriation with a motion made by Jacob Rayl second by Wes Pourchot. Roll Call Vote: 4 ayes, 0 nays, motion carried.

After discussion, the Board approved Ordinance 10-21-25-SD3 Levy and Tax Collection with a motion made by Jacob Rayl second by Wes Pourchot. Roll Call Vote: 4 ayes, 0 nays, motion carried.

Jeremiah Campbell with Rural Med E.M.S. attended the meeting to discuss the possibility of rebuilding an ambulance using the existing chassis. He stated that the estimated cost of the rebuild would be approximately \$160,000, with a potential range between \$120,000 and \$170,000. A 30% down payment would be required upfront, with the remaining balance due upon completion. The rebuild is expected to take approximately three months. It was noted during the discussion that \$212,000 is currently in the bank account. The proposed rebuild would account for more than half of the actual funds. To help manage cash flow, Jeremiah stated that it may be possible to delay payment for insurance until after the first installment of tax payments are made in July 2026, in order to avoid placing the district in a negative financial position

After the discussion, the Board approved the ambulance rebuild with a motion made by Wes Pourchot second by Jacob Rayl. Roll Call Vote: 3 ayes, 1 nay(Myers), motion carried.




There was no New Business.
